Katie Oskey with the Great Smoky Mountain Railroad appeared before the Board requesting the closure of Fry Street from Everett Street to the Smoky Mountain Train Museum from 5 pm Thursday, November 12th through 6 am Monday, January 4, 2016 for the Polar Express Event. Since this is a request for an extended closure the Great Smoky Mountain Railroad will open their parking lot off of Bryson Street to help with parking issues. The Board will make a decision on this matter at the next Board meeting.
