Mayor Tom Sutton called the workshop to order.

Mayor Tom Sutton read a proclamation declaring February 21, 2021 as “Ruby Morgan Day” in honor of her 100<sup>th</sup> birthday.

Pat McConnell gave a power point presentation regarding his trash, water and sewer rates, and charges for his four two-story cabin rentals at his Bryson Village property. He is requesting the Board’s consideration of the following three request: 1) Exempt Bryson Village from the garbage pickup fee. 2) Reclassify the Village’s water and sewer rates to residential. 3) Charge the Village for one water and one sewer service for the four two-story log cabins. The Board discussed these requests with Mr. McConnell.

The Board continued with discussions regarding fire inspections, Academy Street topography mapping and property boundary survey scope of work proposal from Mc\Gill & Associates, and the large item budget requests from the Police Department, Wastewater Plant, Fire Department, and the Town Office.
