The Board reviewed the Black Hill Project Bid in the amount of \$174,540.00 which breaks down as follows: Hyatt Pipeline \$148,140.00, Construction Contingency \$14,800.00, and Construction Administrative/Observation costs \$11,600.00. Hyatt Pipeline was the only bidder for this project. **Ben King made a motion to accept the bid presented for the Black Hill Project in the amount of \$174,540.00; Chad Smith seconded the motion that carried.**
