The Board reviewed the updated Capital Improvement Plan for the Town of Bryson City. **Janine Crisp made a motion to approve this plan as presented; Ben King seconded the motion that carried.**

Ben King made a motion to rescind the street closures for the Christmas Parade that were approved on March 2, 2020; Janine Crisp seconded the motion that carried.

Ben King made a motion to approve the permit fee for a horse drawn carriage business to be \$50.00 per year; Janine Crisp seconded this motion that carried. This fee will be included in the fee schedule for the Town of Bryson City.

Heidi Ramsey-Woodard joined the meeting at 5:45 p.m.

The Board discussed the FEMA Island Park Project. The Board wanted Patrick Breedlove to continue with the work requested of his company regarding Island Park.

The Board discussed a height of buildings potential ordinance. The Board instructed Manager Mathis to contact Attorney Fred Moody regarding State legislation (NC Statute 160D) which could affect any land use ordinances for the Town.

The Board discussed a Land Development Plan for the Town of Bryson City that may be a stipulation from the State legislature (NC Statute 160D) regarding land use ordinances.

The Board looked at a plan for a new solid waste tier program that would affect commercial garbage.
