Mayor Tom Sutton called the special meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

The Board reviewed the information regarding the Pump Station Repairs and SCADA at the Ingles pump station on Hwy 19 South. **Janine Crisp made a motion to approve the repairs; Jim Gribble seconded the motion that carried.**

Peggy Thomas appeared before the Board requesting a variance to the Town's Mobile Home Park Ordinance. Her tenant wants to move out an existing mobile home and replace it with a newer one. According to the ordinance the whole trailer park has to be brought up to the ordinance standard. Mrs. Thomas is asking for a variance from this ordinance. The Board tabled this matter until the October regular meeting.

The Board continued with a workshop session.

Keith Buff with NC Rural Water presented the Board with information regarding cross-connection and back flow prevention of the water system. He also gave the Board information regarding the metering of fire protection systems in the Town's Water system.

Karen Wilmot with the Swain County Chamber of Commerce appeared before the Board requesting an Island Street closure for the Great Bacon Chase Event. The Board reviewed the request and needed a diagram of the event route before making a decision to close the Street.

The Board continued reviewing potential changes to the Town's Ordinances.

Alderman Ben King made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss personnel; Heidi Ramsey-Woodard seconded the motion that carried. Ben King made a motion to close the Executive session and return to the regular meeting; Heidi Ramsey-Woodard seconded the motion that carried.
